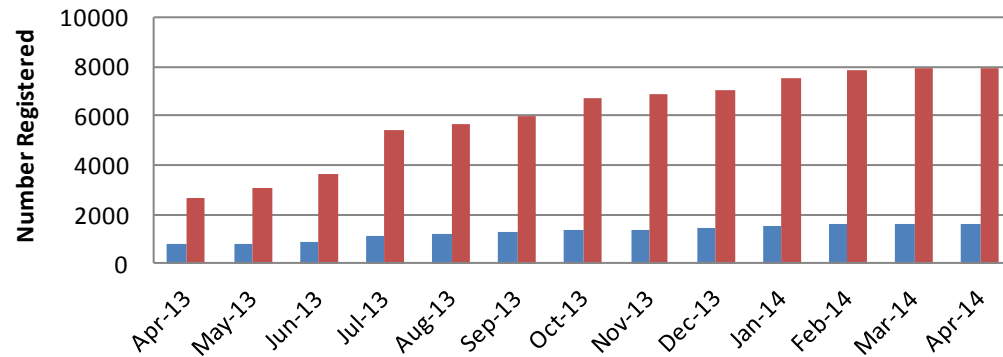

## RECENT ACCOMPLISHMENTS FEBRUARY 2014 – APRIL 2014

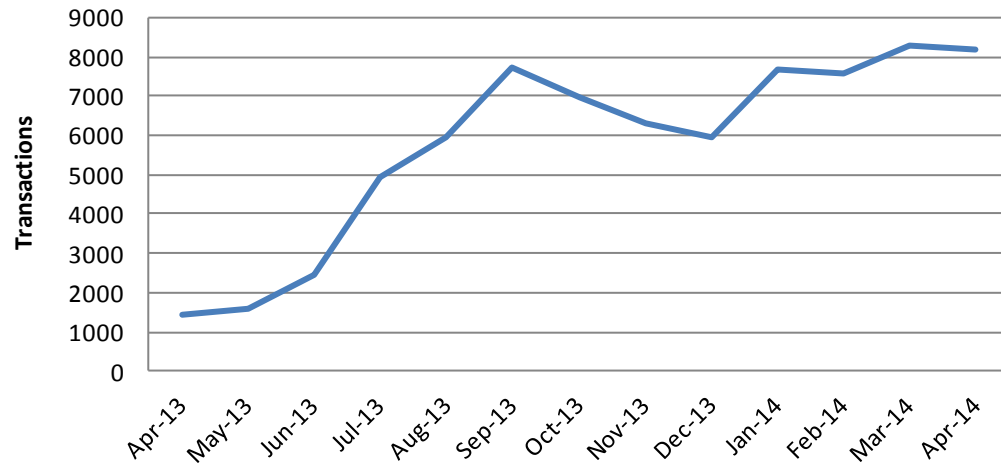
- Direct Secure Messaging (DSM)
  - Released 5.2 to production (database incremental backup and replication)
  - The Florida HIE Direct TrustBundle design was put into production
  - Continued HISP to HISP support with UF Health, Michigan Health Information Network (MiHIN), SureScripts, and Quest
- Event Notification Service (ENS)
  - Alerts are being sent from Broward Health to WellCare Health Plan
- Patient Look-Up (PLU)
  - Martin Health System went live on PLU
  - Tampa Bay RHIO held their technical kick-off to began onboarding
  - Community Health IT submitted an updated Readiness Assessment for facilitated onboarding
  - Bethesda completed validation testing
  - Florida HIE was conditionally accepted as a participant in the eHealth Exchange

## System Usage DSM Total Registered Users



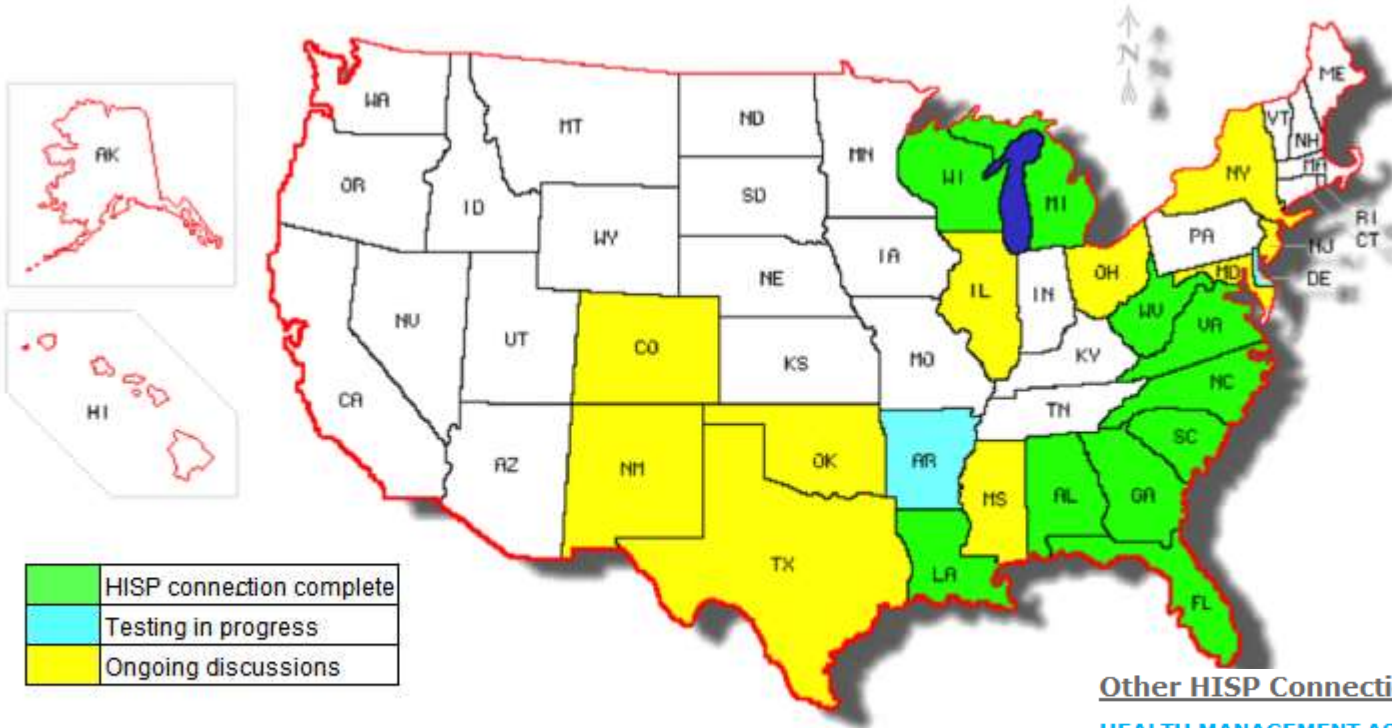

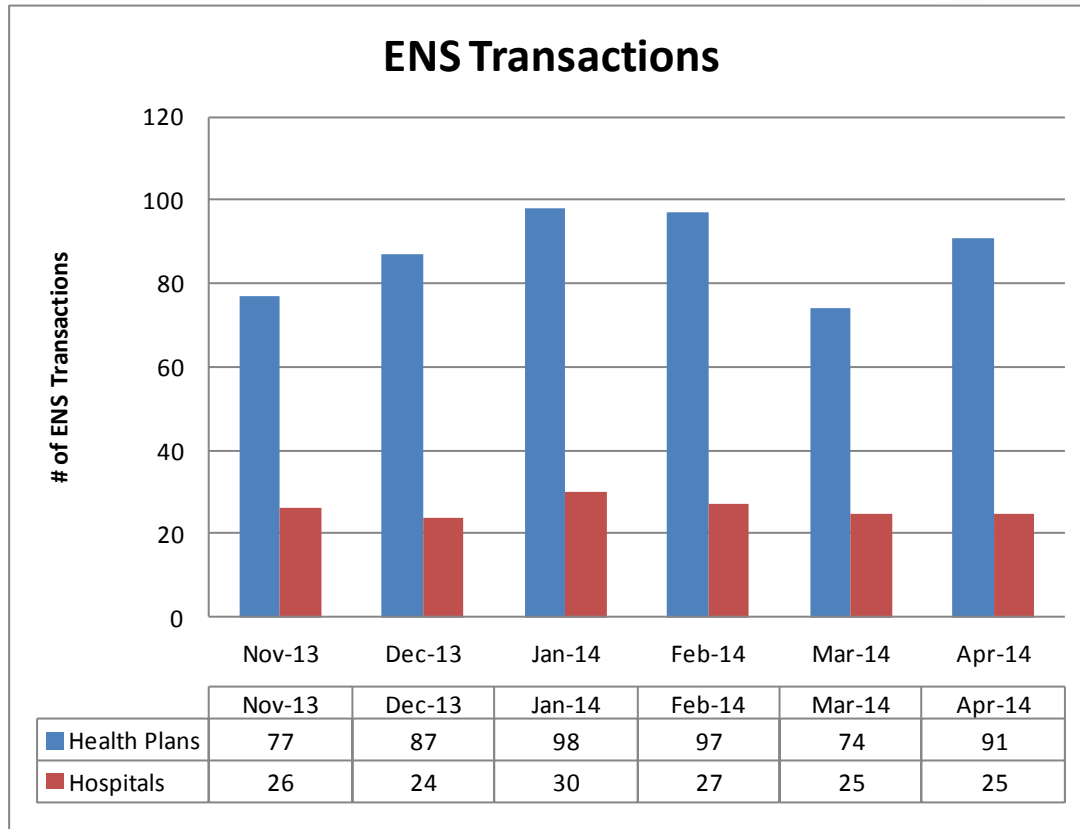

- **Naples Community Hospital** – no request for support this quarter
- **Orlando Health** – worked to resolve issue with network changes that have hindered cross gateway testing; resolved issue with certificate cipher suite interoperability
- **Florida Accountable Care Services (ACO)** - Worked on outbound connectivity from Guardian Services to Express Lite

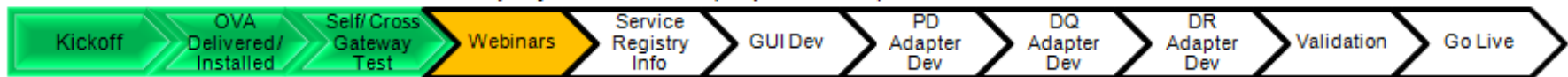

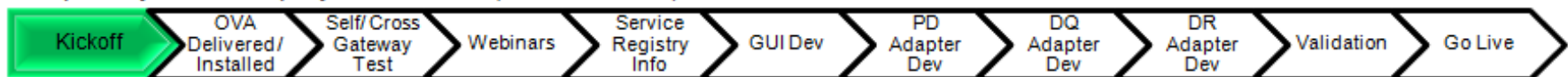

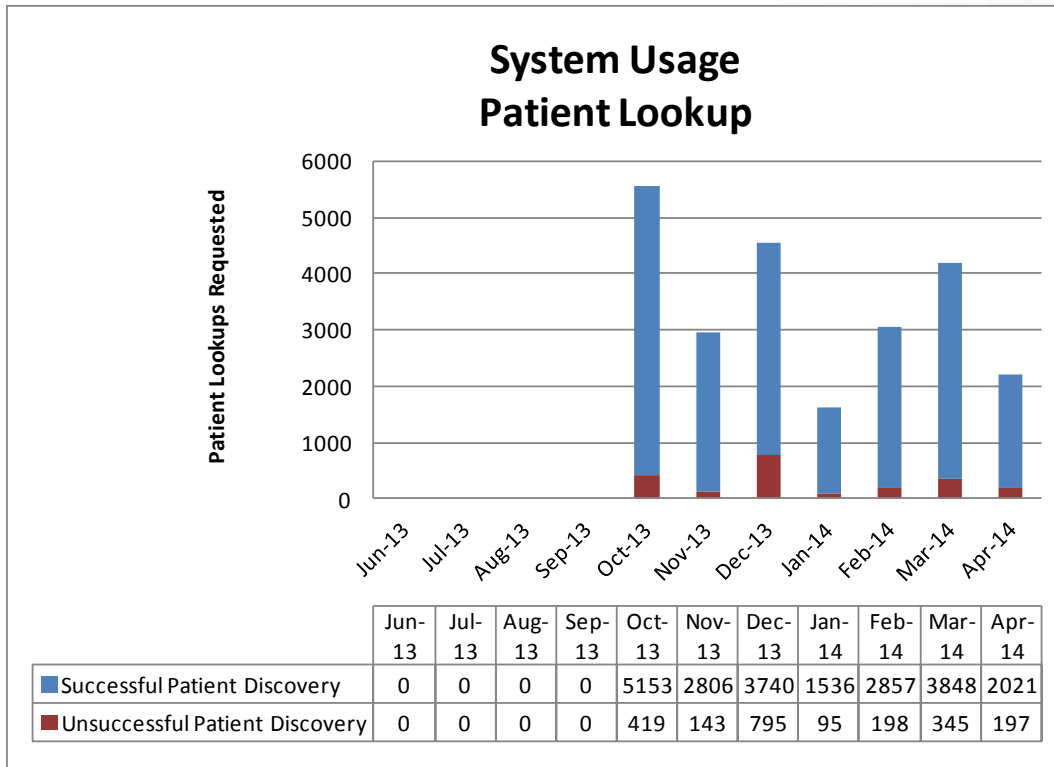


## Florida Accountable Care Services Deployment Status (Express Lite)

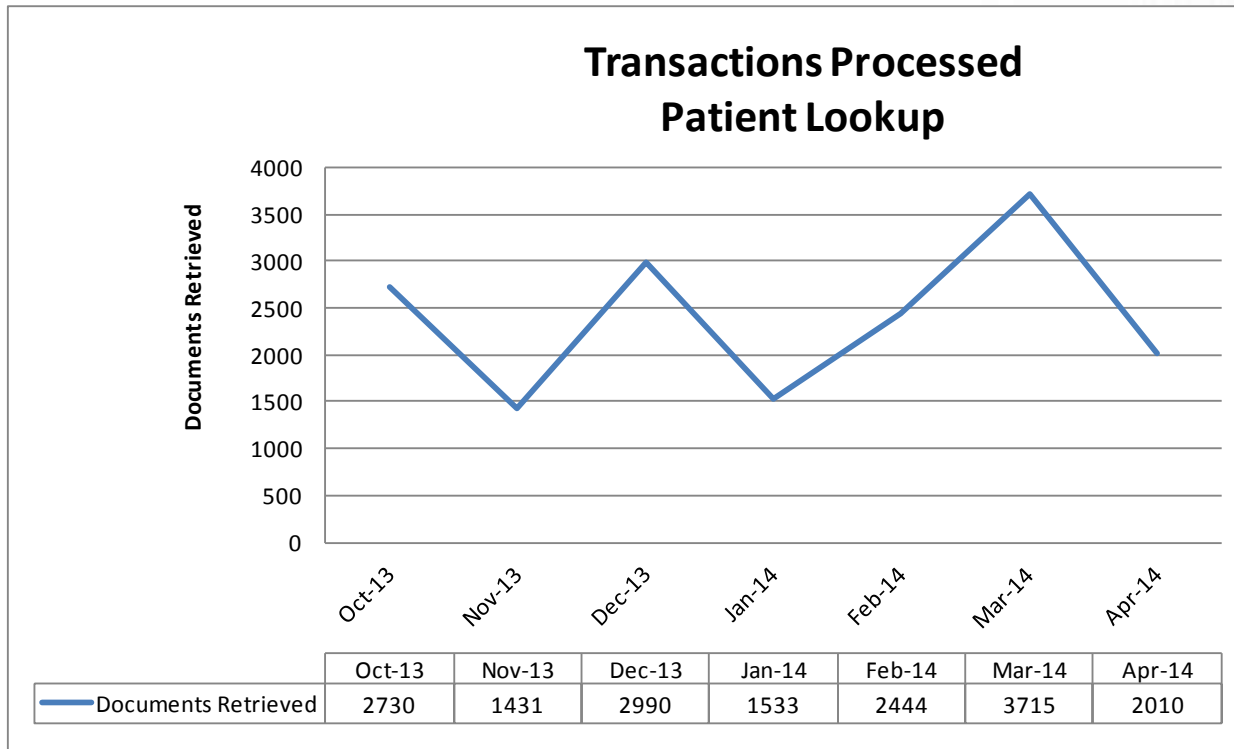
